



1 Mirabell Palace

Address: Mirabellplatz 4, 5020 Salzburg

Product family: STRING-Serie, CONCEPT 2, TUBE 264, customised solution



Prince-Archbishop Wolf Dietrich von Raitenau built Mirabell Palace in 1606 for his mistress and her 15 children.

2 Hotel Sacher Salzburg

The hotel has old connecting doors and smaller staircases, which originally were intended for staff use. Some of them are still in use today.

3 Salzburg State Theatre

The theatre opened in 1893 and has hosted thousands of performances since then. Some Staff report from the stage: footsteps at night and doors moving.

4 House of Nature

The House of Nature has always been a hands-on museum. Since the 1960s, visitors have been able to press buttons and move models there.

5 Salzburg Festival Hall

The big festival hall is partly built directly into the Mönchsberg, with around 55,000 m³ of rock blasted away during its construction in the 1950s.

6 St. Peter's Collegiate Church

St. Peter's Cemetery is one of the oldest in Europe and has been in continuous use for over 1,300 years. Artists, scholars and Mozart's sister Nannerl are buried here.

7 Hohensalzburg Fortress

Hohensalzburg Fortress is one of the largest preserved castle complexes in Europe and has never been conquered in over 900 years. It is a true symbol of "unbreakability".
