



### 1 Artists' House Vienna

**Address:** Karlsplatz 5, 1010 Vienna

**Product family:** STRING ARC, STRING-Series, CONCEPT 2, EyE 90, SPOTS, TUBE 264, customised solution



The Artists' House was built by artists for artists and opened in 1868. To this day, it is considered a symbol of artistic independence.

### 2 Butterfly house

**Address:** Burggarten 1, 1010 Vienna

Inside, the climate is tropical, with temperatures of around 26 °C and humidity of about 80%, creating ideal conditions for around a hundred free-flying butterflies of many different species.

### 3 House of Music

At the House of Music, you can experience a virtual orchestra of the Vienna Philharmonic conduct. If you make the wrong movements, the musicians react in a funny or annoyed way.

### 4 Hotel Royal

Perched on the hotel roof is the Settimo Cielo restaurant, offering a view of St. Stephen's Cathedral – so close that you can see its details from an unusual perspective.

### 5 Dorotheum

Founded in 1707 by Emperor Joseph I, the Dorotheum originally served as a pawnbroker's, where items could be pledged in exchange for money.

### 6 Minorite Church

If you look at the church from the outside, you notice that one tower is missing. It was severely damaged in the 16th century and never rebuilt true to the original.

### 7 Urania Observatory

There is a public observatory on the roof, offering views of planets like Jupiter and Saturn right in the heart of Vienna.
